The Boomer Township School #8

The one-room rural Boomer #8 school, sometimes known as the Mackland School, served the south central portion of Boomer Township in Pottawattamie County, Iowa, north of Council Bluffs. It was located about nine miles west of the town of Neola. The district occupied Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34 of Boomer Township and originally consisted of hilly prairie with some woods, bisected by Pigeon Creek.

I attended Boomer #8 from September 1942 to February 1948.

The Boomer #8 School was probably closed around the mid 1950s.
