## The Lives of Peter Hansen and Dorthe Hansen

My great-grandparents, Peter Hansen and Dorthe Hansen, were married in Radsted Sogn, Maribo Amt, Denmark, on December 14, 1877.

I believe that Peter and Dorthe lived on Peter's parents' farm in Sløsserup in neighboring Toreby Sogn from the time they married until their emigration in 1886.

Peter and Dorthe Hansen had five children, with their oldest, Karen Margrethe "Maggie" Hansen, being my maternal grandmother. Their four older children were born in Denmark, while their youngest child, Ellen Marie, was born after immigrating. The three older children were christened in Toreby church, and Mads Adolf, the fourth child, was christened in Radsted church after his parents emigrated and left him in the care of Dorthe's relatives.

Peter Hansen's last parent died in 1879. I was told that his parents' farm was sold to settle the estate, and this helped motivate Peter to emigrate.

On April 8, 1886, Peter Hansen completed a Copenhagen police immigration form. Peter and Dorthe Hansen probably left Denmark shortly thereafter. They took with them their three older children, but left baby Mads Adolf with relatives in Denmark.

Mads Adolf Hansen, the fourth child of Peter Hansen and Dorthe Hansen, was born in Denmark in 1885. When his parents emigrated in 1886, Mads Adolf remained in Denmark with his mother's sister, Kirstine, and Kirstine's husband, Anders Hansen. Mads Adolf died in 1893 at the age of 7.

Mads Adolf's short life is the subject of the book *A Frame but no Picture*, published by the Lur Press in Blair Nebraska, in 1998. This book consists of letters written to Peter and Dorthe Hansen during their early years in the United States.

Upon arriving in the United States, Peter Hansen first worked for the Rock Island railroad in Weston, ten miles northeast of downtown Council Bluffs. In 1887, while living in Weston, their final child, Ellen Marie, was born next door in the house of a neighbor, Swen Nelson.

After a few years in Weston, the Peter Hansen family moved to Council Bluffs, where Peter worked for the Northwestern Railroad. In Council Bluffs they lived in the North Eighth Street area. While living in Council Bluffs, the Hansen children attended the 8<sup>th</sup> Street School.

In 1895, Peter, Dorthe, and their four children, Maggie, Pete, Chris and Ellie, moved to a farm in Hazel Dell Township, Section 10, which they rented from the Graham estate. In Hazel Dell Township the Hansen children attended the Parish School, at the southwest corner of the intersection north of the Hansen farmstead.

Hansen family members remained on the rental farm in Hazel Dell Township for around 50 years.

In 1900, Peter and Dorthe's oldest child, Maggie, married Andrew Larson, who lived on a nearby farm with his parents. Andrew and Maggie set up housekeeping on an 80-acre

farm near Andrew's parents, which Andrew and Maggie rented from the Graham estate.

My great-grandfather, Peter Hansen, lived to see only two of his grandchildren. He died on the Hansen farm in Hazel Dell Township in 1904, at the age of 67.

After Peter Hansen's death in 1904, his widow, Dorthe, and their unmarried children, Pete, Chris and Ellie, continued to live on the Hansen farm. Pete became the farmer in the family. In the 1919 Pottawattamie County atlas, Pete was farming 120 acres.

In 1913, Chris began studying to become a minister. When school wasn't in session, Chris would return home and work in the neighborhood until he was ordained and married in 1921.

In 1916, Ellie married Andrew Larson's brother, Henry Larson, and left home to live on a nearby farm that Henry had just purchased.

In the 1920 census, Dorthe Hansen was living with her son-in-law and daughter, Henry and Ellie Larson, and their little daughter, Evelyn. Dorthe died at Henry and Ellie's home in Hazel Dell Township in 1923 at the age of 73.

For a quarter of a century, Uncle Pete Hansen lived by himself on the farm his parents had first rented in 1895. I believe that the Graham estate continued to own this farm until around the time Uncle Pete moved away in the 1940s. Then Henry Ted Peterson, the neighbor across the creek to the west, bought the Hansen farm and demolished the buildings.

My great-grandparents, Peter and Dorthe Hansen, and their children, Maggie, Pete and Ellie, are all interred in St. Paul's Lutheran Church Cemetery in Boomer Township, west of Neola, Iowa. Chris is interred in Blair, Nebraska. Mads Adolph was interred in Denmark.

The list on the following two pages shows Peter and Dorthe Hansen's five children and their sixteen grandchildren, along with spouses and birth and death dates. As of February 2016, all grandchildren are deceased, the last to die being Sara (Hansen) Walter in December 2015.
