Chapter 7 Appendix - Locating Maren Larsen's Danish Relatives

Maren Larsen, my great-grandmother, lived north of Copenhagen in northern Sjælland before emigrating with her first husband, Anders Larsen, and their five children in 1870.

This appendix contains various maps of the areas in Denmark where Maren Larsen's ancestors, uncles and aunts, siblings and first husband lived. I wrote it as a reference for Chapter 7, *Maren Larsen's Other Relatives*, of the *Larsen* volume of my extended family history.

Section 1 - Northern Sjælland Overview Maps

In Denmark, most of Maren Larsen's relatives lived in northern Sjælland (Zealand in English). Most lived in or near the triangular area north of Copenhagen bounded by Frederiksværk, Ølstykke and Hillerød, which are all shown below.




Map of North Sjælland (courtesy of krak.dk)



Maren Larsen's Ancestors - Summary Chart




Maren Larsen's Ancestors - Location Summary

Most of the individuals on the above chart lived in Ølsted Sogn. For some, the parishes in which they lived are unknown. Here are the known exceptions:

- Lars Hansen & Ane Kirstine Jensdatter, Maren's parents: born in Ølsted Sogn and moved to Bendstrup, Alsønderup By c. 1838; remaining until their deaths.
- Ane Pedersdatter, Maren's paternal grandmother: born in Sigerslevøster By, Strø Sogn.
- Kirsten Jensdatter, a great grandmother: born in Lilly Lyngby Sogn.
- Marie Hansdatter, Maren's maternal grandmother: born in Udlejre By, Ølstykke Sogn.
- Hans Pedersen, a great grandfather: born in Paastrup, Jørlunde Sogn and lived in Udlejre By.
- Ane Marie Frederiksdatter, a great grandmother: probably spent entire life in Udlejre By.

Maren Larsen's Siblings - Summary Chart

Maren Larsen's parents, Lars Hansen and Ane Kirstine Jensdatter, had ten children, eight of whom lived to maturity and seven married (my great-grandmother, Maren, had two marriages). Elsewhere you will find brief reports on the families of each of these seven children, including Maren's nieces and nephews.

Maren Larsen's Paternal Aunts & Uncles - Summary

All children were born in Ølsted sogn. Søren likely died in childhood. Jens does not belong here.

- Maren Hansdatter lived her entire life in Lillie Lyngby Sogn.
- Kirsten Hansdatter remained in Ølsted Sogn until near her death.
- Lars Hansen moved his family to Bendstrup around 1838.
- **Niels Hansen** remained in Ølsted Sogn.
- **Johanne Hansdatter** lived in Græse from 1838 to 1847 and then returned to Ølsted.
- Bodil Hansdatter married a widower and remained in Ølsted.
- **Birthe Hansdatter** remained in Ølsted, where she probably died.
- Ane Hansdatter and her husband lived in several locations: Ude Sundby 1845 & 1850; Strø 1860; Sigerslevøster 1880. Lars Olsen subsequently died in Karlebo.

Introduction

The organization of Denmark into political units was much different in 1870 when my great-grandmother, Maren Larsen, emigrated with her first family.

In 1870 Denmark was divided into counties (amter), with counties divided into districts (herreder) and districts into parishes (sogne).

Today Denmark is divided into five regions, with regions divided into municipalities (kommuner) and municipalities into parishes. There are around 98 kommuner. The parish organization still exists.

Traditionally the sogn was both the basic local administrative and religious unit. Generally each sogn would have one church (kirke), of the official Danish Lutheran faith. However I know of parishes with more than one church, parishes which sometimes didn't have a church, and today I know of parishes that share one church.

Each rural parish generally includes a number of settlements (bebyggelse) and towns (byer), as befits a society in which historically most people walked most of the time.

As stated earlier, almost all of the older Danish relatives of Maren Larsen that have been located lived north of Copenhagen in the northern part of the island of Sjælland. The next two pages contain herred and kommune index maps of this area.

I follow these index maps with an index of the major sogne in which Maren Larsen's relatives lived.


After the sogn index page are the maps themselves showing where Maren's parents, grandparents, siblings, uncles and aunts, and grandparents lived. Under the maps, I summarize residence information for the relatives who lived in that parish. Most dates in this summary come from census data.

- You can also find kirke (church) photographs at this site. This site does not have an English version.
- In the korttilkirken.dk maps, current sogn boundaries are marked with a black line. Sometimes today's boundaries differ from earlier boundaries.
- In the korttilkirken.dk maps, current sogn boundaries are marked with a black line. Sometimes today's boundaries differ from earlier boundaries.
- The korttilkirken.dk maps I have seen show the parish church location as well as the settlements within the parish.


Alsønderup Sogn



Alsønderup Sogn, containing Alsønderup By & Bendstrup By (5 miles northwest of Hillerød)

- Lars Hansen family moved to Bendstrup from Ølsted c. 1838; six younger children were born in Bendstrup; Lars & Ane Kirstine remained in Bendstrup until their deaths (parents appear in the 1840, 1845, 1850, 1860, 1880 & 1890 censuses).
- Hans Olsen & Karen Larsen (Maren's sister) appear in 1880, 1890 & 1901 Bendstrup censuses.
- Peder Larsen (Maren's brother) & Maren Kirstine Kristiansen appear in 1880, 1890
 & 1901 Alsønderup By censuses.
- **Jens Larsen** (Maren's brother) & Ane Kirstine Mortensen lived in Alsønderup Sogn in 1866-1875.


Grønholt Sogn

• Hans Jørgensen & **Birthe Kirstine Larsen** (Maren's sister) lived in Lønholt By in 1890, 1901, & 1906.


Hillerød, population about 30,000



Inner Hillerød area: Hillerød Kobsted & Frederiksborg Slot Sogne

This shows only a portion of these two parishes. Frederiksborg Slot Sogn surrounds the Hillerød Kobsted (city) parish on the north, west and south. Hillerød Slot is in the center of this map.

- Anders Larsen & Maren Larsen lived in Frederiksborg Slot Sogn, perhaps in Nyhuse, in 1870 before immigrating.
- Hans Larsen's widow, Karen Christensen, lived in Hillerød Kobsted Sogn in 1880 and 1890.



Jørlunde Sogn, containing Jørlunde By (10 miles SW of Hillerød) & Skenkelsø By (12 miles SW of Hillerød)

 Maren Larsen's first husband, Anders Larsen, was born in Jørlunde By and moved to Skenkelsø By as a child.

Lille Lyngby Sogn



Lille Lyngby Sogn, containing Store Lyngby By (8 miles W of Hillerød) & **Meløse By** (6 miles west of Hillerød)

- Mads Larsen (Maren's brother) & Karen Marie Larsen lived in Store Lyngby By in 1880, 1890, and 1901.
- The **Jens Larsen** (Maren's brother) & Ane Kirstine Mortensen family lived in Meløse By in 1880, 1890, and 1901 (she died 1885-1890).


Snostrup & Ølstykke Sogne



Snostrup Sogn, containing Store Rorbæk By (15 miles SW of Hillerød) **Ølstykke Sogn, containing Udlejre By** (15 miles SW of Hillerød) I believe Udlejre By has been absorbed by the expansion of Ølstykke. As of 2010, Ølstykke By has been combined with Stenløse By, with a combined population of 20,000.


- Hans Jørgensen & Birthe Kirstine Larsen (Maren's sister) lived in Store Rørbæk By in 1880.
- Udlejre By was the birthplace **of Marie Hansdatter**, Maren Larsen's maternal grandmother.

Strø Sogn



Strø Sogn, containing Sigerslevøster By (9 miles SW of Hillerød)

• Sigerslevøster By was the birthplace of Ane Pedersdatter, Maren's maternal grandmother.



Tjæreby & Ullerød Sogne

Tjærby Sogn, containing Harløse By (5 miles SW of Hillerød) & Ullerød Sogn, containing Ullerød By (western suburb of Hillerød)
Ullerød Sogn may have been created from Tjærby Sogn and/or Frederiksborg Slot Sogn about 100 years ago.

- Anders Larsen & Maren Larsen lived in Ullerød By, Tjærby Sogn in 1860.
- Hans Jørgensen & **Birthe Kirstine Larsen** (Maren's sister) lived in Harløse By c. 1868-1878.

Ølsted Sogn containing Ølsted By (10 miles west of Hillerød)

- Three of Maren Larsen's grandparents were born in Ølsted Sogn; three grandparents died in Ølsted Sogn.
- Maren's parents, Lars Hansen & Ane Kirstine Jensdatter, wee born, raised and married in Ølsted Sogn.
- Maren and three older siblings were born in Ølsted Sogn.

Maren Larsen's Paternal Aunts & Uncles - Locations

Parish Locations relative to the towns of Hillerød and Ølsted:

- Ølsted Sogn: Ølsted By ~ 12 miles west of Hillerød, which is north of Copenhagen.
- Alsønderup Sogn: Bendstrup By ~ 10 miles northeast of Ølsted.
- Draaby Sogn: ~ 10 miles southwest of Ølsted west of Roskilde Fjord.
- Græse Sogn: Græse By ~ five miles south of Ølsted.
- Karlebo Sogn: Karlebo By ~ 20 miles east of Ølsted & southeast of Hillerød.
- Lille Lyngby Sogn: Store Lyngby By ~ three miles northeast of Ølsted.
- Melby Sogn: Melby By ~ eight miles northwest of Ølsted past Frederiksværk.
- Strø Sogn: Strø By & Sigerslevøster By ~ five miles southeast of Ølsted.
- Ude Sundby Sogn: surrounds Jægerspris By ~ 10 miles southwest of Ølsted past Frederikssund west of Roskilde Fjord on the Hornsherred peninsula.

Maren Larsen's Siblings Locations

- Bendstrup in Alsønderup Sogn NW of Hillerød: Lars Hansen family moved here from Ølsted c. 1838 and parents remained until their deaths (parents present in the 1840, 1845, 1850, 1860, 1880 and 1890 censuses); Hans Olsen & Karen Larsen 1880, 1890 & 1901.
- Alsønderup By NW of Hillerød: Peder Larsen & Maren Kirstine Kristiansen 1880, 1890 & 1901; Jens Larsen & Ane Kirstine Mortensen: c. 1866-1875.
- Store Lyngby By in Lille Lyngby Sogn W of Hillerød: **Mads Larsen** & Karen Marie Larsen 1880, 1890, 1901.
- Meløse By in Lille Lyngby Sogn W of Hillerød: **Jens Larsen** & Ane Kirstine Mortensen 1880, 1890, 1901 (she died 1885-1890).
- Ullerød By in Tjæreby Sogn immediately W of Hillerød: Anders Larsen & Maren Larsen 1860.
- Hillerød By: Karen Christensen, the widow of **Hans Larsen** 1890; Anders Larsen & **Maren Larsen** 1870.
- Harløse By in Tjæreby Sogn W of Hillerød: Hans Jørgensen & **Birthe Kirstine** Larsen c. 1868-1878.
- Store Rørbæk By in Snostrup Sogn south of Frederikssund (not on map): Hans Jørgensen & **Birthe Kirstine Larsen** 1880.
- Lønholt By in Grønholt Sogn E of Hillerød: Hans Jørgensen & **Birthe Kirstine** Larsen 1890, 1901, 1906.
