I am assuming that "Mr. and Mrs. Jens Jensen" in the St. Paul's charter members list refers to **Jens Jensen** (11 Jun 1826 – 17 Jun 1890) and **Theresa Sorensen** (24 Sep 1828 – 6 Apr 1895) who are interred in lot 97 in the St. Paul's Cemetery.

Jens Jensen and Theresa Sorensen were raised and married in Denmark, immigrated in 1872 with their two older children, and lived in Hazel Dell Township, Section 2 east and south of St. Paul's. Descendants still live in the immediate area.

Descendants use the spelling "Jenson". Theresa was sometimes called "Trine" or "Irene". I do not know of Jens and Theresa's Danish origins.

The three children of Jens and Theresa Jensen are listed below.

■ George N. Jenson (29 Jan 1864 – 5 Jun 1909) married Annie Brophy (about 1866 – 30 Dec 1964) in Pottawattamie County on November 17, 1891.

George N. and Annie Jenson lived in southwestern Norwalk Township, in Section 30, where George farmed until his early death. Annie remained on the family farm for many years thereafter.

George N. and Annie Jenson were members of the St. Columbanus Roman Catholic chapel in Weston.

The seven children of George N. and Annie Jenson are listed below.

• James Christopher Jenson (27 Aug 1892 – 27 Jul 1960) married Marion Veronica Smith in Pottawattamie County on June 20, 1923.

James C. Jenson was elected Pottawattamie County Treasurer in 1936.

- Theresa M. Jenson (22 May 1894 25 May 1981) married Walter J. Meder (1895 4 Jun 1965) in Pottawattamie County on January 2, 1924.
- William E. Jenson (20 Sep 1896 4 Jun 1917) died at the age of 20.
- George Victor Jenson (4 Mar 1899 28 May 1905) died as a child.
- Honora Pearl Jenson (13 Mar 1902 -)

- Mary Elizabeth Jenson (12 Sep 1904 after 1964) married Howard Peters Muller (-) in Pottawattamie County on September 3, 1930.
- Michael John Jenson (1908 1908) died as an infant.

George N. and Annie Jenson and four of their children, Theresa, William, George and Michael are interred in the St. Columbanus Cemetery in Weston.

■ Hans Christian Jenson (16 Dec 1866 – 9 Mar 1952) married Olive Grace Scott (16 Feb 1872 – 4 Dec 1967) in Pottawattamie County on December 17, 1890. Olive Scott was the daughter of George Walter Scott and Frances Grace Horn of south central Hazel Dell Township.

Hans Jenson farmed his parents' home place in northeastern Hazel Dell Township, Section 2.

Hans and Olive Jenson were members of the Danish RLDS church in Hazel Dell Township.

Two of Hans and Olive Jenson's sons, Harry Jenson and Frank Jenson, married sisters, Winifred and Genevieve Nusum. Winifred and Genevieve Nusum were the granddaughters of Boomer Township early settlers Lovridge Samuel Axtell and Frances Sarah "Fanny" Wade and the daughters of Dr. George G. Nusum, who practiced in Boomer Township around 1900, and Aggie Jane Axtell. After Dr. Nusum's early death, Aggie (Axtell) Nusum married William Avid Swanson.

Two of Hans and Olive Jenson's sons, Hans Jenson Jr. and Asa Jenson, married sisters, Mabel and Florence Young. Mabel and Florence Young were the granddaughters of **St. Paul's charter members Ole and Karen Marie Jensen** and the daughters of Norwalk Township residents Henry Young and Emma Jensen.

The twelve children of Hans and Olive Jenson, all of whom lived into adulthood and married, are listed below.

• George Henry Jenson (22 Jun 1891 – 9 Mar 1955) married Dora Christine Nelson (24 May 1891 – 12 Oct 1969) in Pottawattamie County with the St. Paul's pastor officiating on February 18, 1915. Dora Nelson was the daughter of St. Paul's early members Swen Nelson and Helene Sandstrom. See the Swen Nelson section of the Johan Frederik Sandstrom sketch for information about Dora Nelson's relatives.

George and Dora Jenson farmed in Hazel Dell Township, Section 2.

 - ▲ Francis Lynn Jenson (31 Aug 1918 8 Sep 1985) married Ethel Irene Erickson (10 Sep 1919 31 Jan 2010) at St. Paul's on December 26, 1941. Ethel Erickson was the daughter of St. Paul's early members Peter Erickson and Anina Christensen.

Francis Jensen farmed in Boomer Township, Section 35, formerly the Samuel Jensen farm.

• Frank James Jenson (3 May 1894 – 19 Aug 1924) married Genevieve Hope Nusum (Nov 1899 -) in Pottawattamie County on June 25, 1919. Frank Jenson died young and Genevieve later married Ernest Eitner (1899 -).

Louis and Laura Hansen are interred in the Grange Cemetery in Boomer Township.

 Opal Olive Jenson (14 Oct 1900 – 12 Nov 1996) married William Martin Petersen (25 Oct 1899 – 9 Feb 1965) at her parents' home on October 10, 1923. William Martin Petersen was the son of St. Paul's early members Lars C. Petersen and Inger Marie Jensen.

William Martin and Opal Petersen had no children. See the Lars C. Petersen section of the Vilhelm Pedersen sketch for additional information.

• **Bess Marie Jenson** (9 Oct 1902 – 24 Jun 1995) married **John C. Johnsen** (2 Aug 1898 – Feb 1985) at her parents' home on February 28, 1923. John C. Johnsen was the son of **John S. Johnson and Winnifred Caster** of Norwalk Township.

John C. Johnsen farmed in Boomer and Neola Townships before moving to the Logan, Iowa area.

The four children of John and Bess Johnsen are listed below.

Hans and Mabel Jenson farmed west of Underwood.

Hans and Mabel Jenson had no children.

Hans and Mabel Jenson are interred in the Grange Cemetery in Boomer Township.

Asa Orin Jenson (5 Apr 1908 – 23 or 24 May 1981) married Florence Young (22 Mar 1910 – 17 Jan 1999) at the radio station KFNF studio in Shenandoah, Iowa on February 22, 1930.

The two sons of Asa and Florence Jenson are listed below. Both became clergymen.

- ▲ Asa Orin Jenson Jr. (24 Nov 1930 -) married Earle Ione "Ione" Shockey.
- ▲ Dale Thomas Jenson (6 Sep 1935 -) married Charlotte Ann Sorensen.

Asa and Florence Jenson are interred in the St. Paul's Cemetery.

Goldie Lorene Jenson (8 Sep 1910 – Mar 1985) married Chester H. Feller (12 Mar 1915 – 13 Mar 1975) at the Rev. Fred C. M. Hansen home in Council Bluffs on March 19, 1938. Chester Feller was the son of Hans Feller and Sena Nielsen who farmed in Boomer and Neola Townships.

Chester and Goldie Feller had one child. See the **Hans Feller and Sena Nielsen section of the Anton Nielsen sketch** for more information.

Chester and Goldie Feller are interred in the Grange Cemetery in Boomer Township.

• Doris Evelyn Jenson (26 Oct 1913 – 21 Mar 1998) married Orville R. Johnson (26 Sep 1912 – 27 Nov 1997) in 1935. Orville Johnson was the son of Nels P. Johnson and Anna Petersen of east central Hazel Dell Township.

Orville and Doris Johnson evidently had no children.

Orville and Doris Johnson are interred in Ridgewood Cemetery in Council Bluffs.

Hans and Olive Jenson and six of their children, Harry, Frank, Mae, Laura, Hans Christian Jr., and Goldie, are interred in the Grange Cemetery in Boomer Township. George and Asa Jenson are interred in the St. Paul's Cemetery. Opal (Jenson) Petersen is interred in the Cedar Lawn Cemetery in Council Bluffs. Bess (Jenson) Johnson is interred near Logan in Harrison County. Doris (Jenson) Johnson is interred in the Ridgewood Cemetery in Council Bluffs. I don't know where Hazel (Jenson) Conant is interred.

■ Christian Jenson (Sep 1874 – 14 Mar 1909) married Emma Hansen (Mar 1881 - ?) in Pottawattamie County on January 11, 1899. Emma Hansen appears to be the daughter of Jacob Hansen and Annie Hansen of Hazel Dell Township, Section 1.

After 1900, Christian and Emma Jenson moved to Edenboro, Canada, where Christian Jenson died at a young age.

Christian and Emma Jenson had at least two children.

- Viola Jensen

Jens and Theresa Jensen are interred in the St. Paul's Cemetery. Their son, George N. Jenson, is interred in St. Columbanus Cemetery in Weston. Their son, Hans Jenson, is interred in the Grange Cemetery. I don't know where their son, Christian Jenson, is interred.
