

Shelby F. Newman moved to Avoca with his mother after his father's early death in Alabama. They lived in the Meier family home, while his mother taught in the Avoca public schools for many years.

Shelby Newman joined the army after graduating from the University of Iowa and doing post-graduate work. The Philippine Army battalion he co-commanded was one of the few who fought the Japanese on the invasion beaches of Luzon in December 1941. He was later captured and subsequently was killed at Subic Bay while attempting to escape from the disabled hell ship *Oroyku Maru*, which was taking prisoners of war to Japan.
