Alvin V. Niemann's father, Fred Niemann, was associated with various businesses in Avoca and Council Bluffs, and at times lived on the family farm in Fairview Township north of Avoca. Alvin was working in his father's pool hall in Avoca in 1930 and was a mechanic in Avoca in 1940.

Do not confuse Alvin V. Niemann's brother, Theodore, with Ted Nieman, probably not a relative, who also owned a pool hall in Avoca later.

Alvin V. Niemann entered service in July 1942 and went overseas in November 1942. He returned to the United States in April 1943 and was discharged in August 1943, thus entering the care of the Veterans Administration.
