

Frederick T. Rohlfs was born and raised in Avoca and ordained as a Presbyterian clergyman. In 1939, he married Thelma Lewis of Calvin, North Dakota. He was serving at Afton, Iowa, southwest of Des Moines, when he joined the US Army in June 1941. He was on reserve status at the time of his death, about ten miles northeast of Afton.

Thelma Rohlfs remained in Avoca and raised her children as a single mother. In 1982, Thelma married Edward Kennedy, a widower from Avoca.
